There were hundreds of cars from every make, model, and year – including many rare “never before seen” cars. There was a barn find section that was jaw dropping and had something for everyone's taste. It was like going to car heaven!

This is also the perfect place to sell your car, too. The Auto Mall is open six days a week, with interested parties traveling to see the rare finds every day. Once you place your car for sale there, you get 90 days in the indoor showroom for free, with an option to extend for an additional 90 days (for a fee) if your car doesn't sell.

A 10% commission on your sale is all the Auto Mall requests to have your car on display in their high-traffic indoor showroom. Applications and additional information will be made available at our April meeting.

2019 ENTHUSIAST DAY PLANNED AT BODYMOTION IN OCEAN


