## AMCOMC CONTINUES DONATION STREAK, MORE PLANNED SOON



**F**OLLOWING up on the major success of our annual Thanksgiving Can-Can Food Drive, AMCOMC switched gears this winter and delivered a large donation to the community. On the heels of our largest food delivery ever to LunchBreak, AMCOMC donated seven (7) 55-gallon plastic bags of coats for their winter coat drive. Upon delivery, the coats were immediately placed onto racks and were available for selection at Red Bank's LunchBreak.

Along with the coats, there was an abundance of non-winter clothing to go along with it. Although some facilities could only take winter clothing due to space constrictions, we were able to find accepting parties for the non-winter items to spread our reach into local communities. The additional clothing and shoes were donated and delivered to St. Agnes Church in Atlantic Highlands, who received 25 large 55-gallon bags.

We thank Webmaster Danielle Fitzgerald for coming up with the idea for this winter coat and clothing drive and all AMCOMC members who were able to donate!

Due to our overwhelming support of other initiatives, LunchBreak has asked for our support in their summer drive, FOODSTOCKUP2020, where they will need to raise more than 150,000 pounds of food to meet demand from the community.
