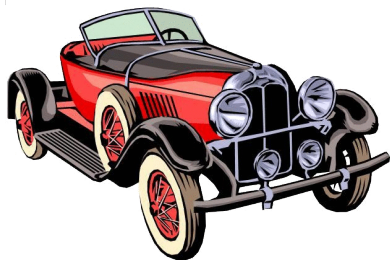
FIRST GARAGE TOUR PLANNED
