FIRST EVENT PLANNED FOR 2019

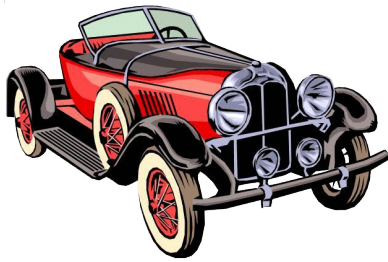
