TECH TIPS



This month's 'Tech Tip' is more of a safety tip. Anyone who has owned an antique vehicle knows that one of the most essential tools to have is a fire extinguisher.

As we begin our new season, you'll want to perform a safety check and ensure that your extinguisher is still active and fully charged – some lose their pressure if they've just been sitting around. First, you'll want to check the expiration date. If the extinguisher is expired or nearing expiration, you can risk the chemicals losing efficacy and the ability to fight the fires.

You can also check the push pin to see if it resets. The pin is multi-color (green, red, and white are the most commonly used). If it sticks or does not retract, it's time for a replacement.

Most importantly, just make sure you have one in your car! You or another driver will thank you later.
